



Tracking Municipal Fiscal Year 2015 Tax **Receipts after Two Months**

INCOME TAX ESTIMATE

Receipts grew by 8.1% to \$97.46 per capita for the year ended April 30, 2014. Our estimate was \$97.20 for that period.

In the first two months of the current year, revenues are down by 9.3%. This was due to unusual one-time receipts in May 2013. Our \$97.80 estimate for the current year will require 3.3% growth in the next ten months.

LOCAL SHARE OF STATE USE TAX ESTIMATE

Receipts grew by 7.2% to \$17.06 per capita for the year ended April 30, 2014. Our estimate was \$17.00 for that period.

In the first two months of the current year, revenues are up by 19.3%. Our \$17.80 estimate for the current year will require 2.0% growth in the next ten months.

MUNICIPAL SHARE OF MOTOR FUEL TAX ESTIMATE

Receipts grew by 2.2% to \$24.56 per capita for the year ended April 30, 2014. Our estimate was \$24.65 for that period.

In the first three months of the current year, revenues are up by 6.2%. Our \$24.30 estimate for the current year will be reached if receipts do not decline by more than 3.4% in the next nine months.

CORPORATE PERSONAL PROPERTY REPLACEMENT TAX ESTIMATE

Receipts grew by 14.4% to \$1.407 billion for the year ended April 30, 2014. Our estimate was \$1.38 billion for that period.

In the first two months of the current year, revenues are down by 14.0%. Our \$1.38 billion estimate for the current year will require 0.8% growth in the next ten months.
