 - 1.1 Call to order, chair P. Denise Israel called to order 10:00 a.m.

2. Approval of the minutes; Dan C. moved, Jan G. seconded that the minutes of 2-10-15 be approved all say aye.
3. Old business;
 - 3.1 April 25th Roadside Trash Pick-up; Jan G. reports that he does in fact have enough team leaders, but more are always welcome. Contact with the high school still needs to be made for students needing hours. President Mc Laughlin offered to share his daughters and friends contact info, also Gary G. will try high school recruitment thru his daughter. Josie C. will take care of the food for the event.
 - 3.2 Earth week – April Prairie Middle School Initiative & HEC Response: Jennifer K. reports still looking for volunteers and targeting seniors and adults for composting. Scheduling is conflicting with the ACT testing and as of now the Green Team at the high school is not functioning.
 - 3.3 Teasel Attack; P. Denise reports that the teasel attack is not scheduled as of now. P. Denise has also made contact with Jeff Weiss and would encourage new weed scouting groups thru the forest preserve. Jeff Weiss said Ann Spake leads the group and P. Denise will go along to listen and learn. Jeff Weiss has identified 7-9 invasive weeds and that Clopyralid (Transline) is the herbicide of choice instead of Round Up.
College of Lake County and the Morten Arboretum teaches classes to volunteers about weed scouting for more information contact P. Denise.
I.D.O.T. has no maintenance program or budget at this time to assist in the teasel attack.
 - 3.4 Building and Grounds; Loraine B. has no report
 - 3.5 Updates; P. Denise reports that Citizens for Conservation plant sale is going on now with a pick up date of May 1st. College of Lake County will hold its annual native plant sale 5-7 and 5-8
4. New Business
 - 4.1 Garbage Trucks Report & Recycling Buildings; No report
 - 4.2 Recycle/Reuse/Recork; P. Denise suggests that the H.E.C. begin promoting a collection of all wine corks; and noted that the foyer barrel used for Christmas lights is free. The discussion about composite corks and natural corks, if they need to be separate in the recycle drop off. Robert K. agreed to discover if the initiative composite and or just cork.
