Chairman Gohl reviewed and approved the minutes from the October 7, 2014 meeting.

Chairman Gohl introduced the representatives from PSAP Concepts and Solutions and requested for them to highlight the study findings.

Jerry Bleck, Richard Tuma and Sherrill Ornberg each commented on their portion of the study and the pros and cons of consolidated dispatch, as well as the cost savings for the village.

There were several questions from guests and the question of the quality of service if Barrington Hills goes to a consolidated dispatch center. Beth Heitkamp, from QuadCom advised that all their dispatchers are well trained and would each have a ride-a-long with a Barrington Hills officer if we consolidate to assist in their learning our jurisdiction.

Barbara Kemp also discussed ng911 and stressed her belief that the village should wait to make a decision until after April to see what funding may be available to assist Barrington Hills should we choose to keep our own dispatch center.

Chairman Gohl advised that the consolidation was on the agenda for the December 18, 2014 Board of Trustees meeting and that he would bring forward the concerns raised in this meeting.
