1. ORGANIZATIONAL: The meeting of the Village of Barrington Hills Roads & Bridges Committee was called to order by Chairman Cecola at 4:00 PM.

2. *PUBLIC COMMENTS:* Dan Sheldon spoke regarding Longmeadow Parkway, requesting that the Village seek potential ways to delay or prevent the project from moving forward. Mr. Sheldon questioned the legality of Kane County DOT proceeding with Section D prior to having funding in place for Sections B and C. Mr. Sheldon also questioned whether Kane County DOT or IDOT was leading the land acquisition process.

Trustee Gohl asked Mr. Kosin if the Village of Barrington Hills has an ordinance that would prohibit the tree removal within Longmeadow Parkway. Mr. Kosin indicated he would clarify whether the Village would require a permit from another governmental agency.

Linda Cools spoke regarding Longmeadow Parkway, expressing concerns with the elimination of open space and impacts to Village character. Ms. Cools asked several questions regarding the potential impacts of the project.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes of the Roads & Bridges Committee Meeting of January 9, 2017 were approved as written.

4.1 GREEN RAIL BRIDGE JURISDICTION: Mr. Gordon noted that Village staff had met with Cuba Township Highway Commissioner Randy Marks regarding the shared jurisdiction of the Green Rail Bridge, with the Township and Village having equal shares. Trustee Cecola noted that in the past this had been understood through a hand shake agreement and that a memorandum would be completed to reflect this understanding. Mr. Kosin noted that this would simply be a statement of existing conditions.

4.2 BARRINGTON HILLS FARMS- HARPS FACILITY- DRIVEWAY PERMIT: Mr. Gordon noted that GHA had issued a letter approving the site access from Church Road on February 10, 2017. Trustee Cecola noted that he understood the applicant was still waiting for the site development permit from McHenry County.

4.3 IDOT & COUNTY ROAD PROGRAM UPDATE: Mr. Gordon noted that Dan Strahan had attended a meeting at CMAP at which several county and state agencies provided updates on their 2017 Road Programs. Mr. Gordon noted that the Cook County Division of Transportation & Highways confirmed their 2017 Road Program included the design of resurfacing on both Brinker Road and Otis Road west of Brinker, with construction either in the fall of 2017 or in the spring of 2018. Trustee Gohl noted drainage issues along the section of Otis Road east of Brinker near the Hawthorn Lake bridge, as well as sight distance issues at Otis & Old Sutton.

4.4 WINTER CONDITIONS UPDATE: Mr. Gordon noted that based on current weather patterns the seasonal weight restrictions will be posted on February 27, 2017, which is earlier than normal. Mr. Kosin noted that the weight restrictions are communicated through the Building Department and Police Department to minimize potential impacts to residents and permit applicants.

4.5 STORM SEWER MAINTENANCE: Mr. Gordon noted two drainage issues that had arisen on Woodcreek Road and Honeycutt Road, recommending that American Underground perform maintenance at both locations. Mr. Kosin noted that these measures are not typical, but reflect sections of storm sewer that require more than typical maintenance.

4.6 CHAPEL ROAD DEPRESSION: Mr. Gordon summarized drainage issues on Chapel Road, noting that GHA would review pavement elevations to determine if the pavement is sinking due to existing wetlands in the area. Trustee Cecola noted his preference would be to defer maintenance until after construction of the HARPS facility is completed. Trustee Cecola asked if records have been kept regarding the fold-down signage on Chapel Road; Mr. Kosin noted that R&J Tree Service typically handles the signage and he would check with them. Mr. Kosin agreed that delaying the resurfacing would help better define how the pavement is being affected in the wetland area. Trustee Gohl suggested contacting the property owner to the south to explore ways to lower the water elevation.

<u>4.7 ENBRIDGE PROJECT UPDATE – RIVER/ALGONQUIN ROAD:</u> Mr. Gordon provided an update regarding the Enbridge pipeline maintenance, noting that work was in progress and the overweight permit had been issued. Mr. Kosin noted that the largest equipment required an overweight permit as well as an escort to the site. Trustee Cecola noted that a fee was assessed for the overweight permit and that a video of the roadway conditions was taken prior to the start of the project.

5. ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 4:42.

Design efforts for the 2017 Road Program are currently in progress; the following is the anticipated bid schedule:

Tuesday, April 25, 2017 Bid advertisement Thursday, May 11, 2017 Bid opening Roads & Bridges Committee Review Thursday, May 18, 2017 **Board of Trustees Review** Tuesday, May 23, 2017

Based on discussions at the February Roads & Bridges Committee meeting, there were concerns with the proposed resurfacing of Chapel Road and Church Road given the pending construction of the HARPS facility at the south end of Church Road. To address this concern, consideration should be given to finalizing the scope of the 2017 Road Program at the March meeting. Below is the originally anticipated scope, alongside an alternate project scope reflective of the anticipated construction on Church Road (the approved budget for Road Maintenance Contracts is \$960,000):

Within the next several weeks, it is anticipated that spring plantings will be completed for the Veterans' Crossing project, weather permitting (see attached notice to contractor). In particular, replacement trees required by IDOT will be planted and any remaining punchlist work completed.

The original contract cost as awarded was \$1,103,087.10, while Resolution 16-16 amended the Local Agency Agreement for construction costs up to \$1,182,000.00. Approved authorizations for various additional work items (including additional costs due to utility delays and the July 2016 IDOT shutdown) are expected to total \$40,000, pending submittal of a final authorization for additional traffic control due to the extension of time. The anticipated final project cost is approximately \$1,145,000, representing a 3.8% increase over the awarded contract.

Chuck,

Happy New Year! I am writing to give an update on the open Cuba Road bridge project and state the work that still needs to be completed. Currently, the project is still suspended pending the spring for the planting of trees. In that regard, the weather has been looking promising however, the planting period for this contract is spring only.

There are five (5) Quercus Rubra (Red Oak) and four (4) Acer Saccharum (Sugar Maple) trees to be planted. We will resume the contract, once a time is agreed upon, and you will have one week to complete the plantings and all other deficiencies on the punch list, if needed. There are only 5 working days remaining on the contract.

As you are already aware, the planting of these trees require material inspection by IDOT. We spoke with Melissa del Rosario from the Bureau of Maintenance and she informed us that you will have to get these trees recertified because it was inspected a year ago. We don't believe this will be an issue; especially if they are still located at Gerdes Nursery. You will just have to request another IDOT inspection.

Attached you will find the two inspection report from last year for your reference. Please start to think about when you plan to complete this work and schedule accordingly.

Re: Enbridge Pipeline Maintenance

Project Update

Enbridge is currently engaged in pipeline maintenance work within the ComEd right-of-way north of Algonquin/River Road, just west of Braeburn Road. Though the work itself is located outside of the Village, construction access and haul routes are utilizing Village roadways.

Work began the week of January 23 and is expected to continue through May. The initial overweight permit was issued on January 16 for material and equipment deliveries through February 12, using a haul route of Haegers Bend Road to Algonquin/River Road to the site. The overweight permit has been extended to include overweight vehicles expected through March 24 and includes an additional surcharge due to the seasonal load limits currently in place as of February 27, 2017.

A project update has been requested and is expected to be received before the Roads & Bridges Committee meeting.





Crabapple Drive is a Village maintained roadway that runs north-south between Donlea Road and Aberdeen Drive. While the roadway improvements end at Aberdeen Drive, there also exists a private gravel driveway to the south of Aberdeen Drive which has occasionally been misunderstood by mapping programs as an extension of Crabapple Drive. This driveway is located within an area designated on the Plat of Subdivision of Barrington Donlea South Subdivision as a "33' dedication for Highway Purposes." This half right-of-way was later vacated by the Village.



At the request of Village staff and to prevent any confusion regarding the status of this drivway, our office has collected the attached documents that pertain to the dedicated and then vacated right-of-way/easement for Crabapple Drive south of Aberdeen Drive. The following documents are attached:

- Excerpted page from Barrington Donlea South Subdivision (1958), Cook County Doc. No.
- 1980 Plat of Survey for 45 Sandalwood, noting 33' Subdivision dedication as well as 30' Ingress/Egress Easement (document has been ordered but not yet received at time of publication of meeting packet).
- 2003 Plat of Vacation prepared by GHA; vacation approved by Village Board per Ordinance No. 03-15.





In 2007 the Village vacated the southermnost portion of Crabapple Road from Aberdeen/Windy Hill Drive to and easement that allowed our Home, 260 Otis Road and 50 Crabapple access to Crabapple.
