December 2014 Summary of Activity

Burglary / Theft

A resident reported that they had left their residence for an hour and left the home unsecured. During that time, someone entered their home and removed jewelry from the master bedroom. The scene was processed. Fingerprints located at the scene were collected for processing.

The following day, a Plum Tree Road resident, while out jogging, located a plastic bag that contained jewelry. The jewelry turned out to be the jewelry taken in the burglary. The jewelry was identified and returned to the victim. Case remains under investigation.

A resident reported a delayed theft of silver from the residence. The items were last seen a few months ago. There are currently no suspects or leads.

A resident reported their address sign, which was posted at the end of their driveway was stolen. No one was seen in the area.

Criminal Damage to Property

A resident reported that she observed a bicyclist remove and damage a "No Bike Lanes in Barrington Hills" sign, and wanted to sign a complaint. The bicyclist was issued a local ordinance citation along with a court date.

Criminal Trespass to Property

A resident reported someone had entered the utility room of her residence, which is posted "No Trespassing". She stated further, that she had chased him off the property. The subject was later apprehended by BHPD. A complaint was signed and a notice to appear in court issued.

A resident returned from an extended absence and discovered someone had entered his residence. A broken window was located, but nothing was damaged or missing from the home.

DUI / No DL / Suspended / Revoked DL / Possession of Cannabis

DUI – 1 citation; No Valid Driver's License – 3 citations; Suspended/Revoked Driver's License – 2 citations; Possession of Cannabis – 1 citation.

Harassment

A resident reported his daughter receiving a harassing text message. Due to it being a juvenile matter, the school resource officer is working to solve the problem.

Domestic

Officers responded to two domestics during this reporting period. There were no signs of a battery. Domestic violence handbooks were issued. No further action taken.

Lockout

Officers responded to four vehicle lockouts. Entry was gained.

Alarms

Officers responded to two burglar alarms with an unsecured door. The premise was checked for signs of burglary, with none being noted and key-holder was notified.

Premise Checks

One unsecured door was located while checking homes on house watch. Key holder was notified and the premise was secured.

Lost / Found Property

A resident reported he lost an ID card issued by the courthouse. A report was taken for documentation only.

A "Game Works" game card was found in the parking lot of the Village Hall. The game card was placed into evidence storage for safe keeping.

Shots Fired

A report of shots fired was received in the area of Bateman Road / Algonquin Road. The officer located a subject target shooting. The subject stated he did not have a permit. The officer explained the village ordinance requiring a permit and issued a citation for shooting without a permit. A court date is pending.
