As defined in Section 6-2-4 of the Village Code:

STREET, COLLECTOR: A public street which distributes local traffic between local minor streets and area service roads, discourages use by through traffic, does not extend across area service roads and serves not more than four hundred (400) dwelling units.

It is also noted that on the IDOT Functional Classification Maps, the following roads are listed as "Major Collectors" within Algonquin Township:

- Haeger's Bend Road
- Spring Creek Road
- Algonquin/River Road
- Plum Tree Road
