

Ordinance No. 05 - 05

**ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS
ZONING CODE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5-10-6 of the Village Code, certain Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village") proposed amendments to the Village Code;

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals on June 20, 2005, conducted a public hearing in accordance with Section 5-10-6 of the Village Code, and has found that the amendments are in the public interest and not solely for the benefits of the applicants; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has provided the President and Board of Trustees with a written report recommending the adoption of the proposed amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section One: Section 5-2-1 of the Zoning Code, "Definitions" shall be, and the same hereby is, amended to add the following definitions:

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY: "Animal husbandry" shall mean the breeding and raising of livestock, such as horses, cows and sheep, but specifically excluding dogs and cats.

Section Two: Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section Three: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.


