

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND
INSTALLATION OF RADIO EQUIPMENT FOR
THE B.A.R.N. NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the “Village”) located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry in the State of Illinois, is a home rule municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Village and the Village of Barrington, Illinois entered into an intergovernmental agreement (“Intergovernmental Agreement”) to operate and maintain a joint radio communications antenna network and common frequency for such network known as the Barrington Area Radio Network (“B.A.R.N.”) (see a copy of the Intergovernmental Agreement attached as Exhibit A hereto and made a part hereof); and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village, it is for the best interests of the Village to purchase and install the following radio equipment for use with B.A.R.N.: Digitac Comparator and Quantar Repeater Transmitter with receiver (the “Equipment”) from Chicago Communications LLC (see the Equipment Quote for the BARN Network Infrastructure and Standard Terms and Conditions of Sale attached as Exhibit B hereto and made a part hereof); and

WHEREAS, the Equipment’s actual costs is \$41,742.15 and the Village, pursuant to the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement, is responsible for forty percent (40%) of the costs and expenses of operating and maintaining the B.A.R.N., or \$16,696.86 of the cost of the Equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake, and McHenry in the State of Illinois, a home rule municipality as follows:

Section 1: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2: Purchase of Radio Equipment. The President and Board of Trustees hereby find the purchase of the above-described Equipment to be necessary and useful to the Village, and the President of the Village is hereby authorize, direct and empower the Barrington Hills Police Department to purchase the Equipment in the amount of \$16,696.86 pursuant to the Standard Terms and Conditions of Sale.

Section 3: Validity. Should any part of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
