

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2
OF THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS CODE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills has determined it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its citizens, to provide that the Board of Health of the Village be given the authority to review and make recommendations regarding the regulation regarding the withdrawal of water by wells located within the Village planning area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section One: Section 2-6-4 of the Village Code shall be, and the same hereby is, amended to add the following subsection:

- (F) To review the installation of water wells in the Village and to make recommendations regarding the adoption of regulations in order to preserve the quantity of potable water available to the residents of the Village.

Section Two: Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section Three: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.


