

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL FUND FOR THE PREVENTION OF DRUG AND GANG ACTIVITY AND TO REDUCE ALCOHOL-RELATED VIOLENCE IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Barrington Hills (“Village”) it is for the best interest of the Village to create and establish a Drug/Gang/DUI Fund under the Village’s home rule authority over such matters.

WHEREAS, the Drug/Gang/DUI Fund will be funded through private donations and revenue received by the Village under subsection 5/11-501(j) of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-501 (the “DUI Statute”)), for arrests made in the Village that result in a person being found or pleading guilty to driving under the influence.

WHEREAS, the President and the Village Board of Trustees at its regularly scheduled meeting of March 27, 2006, determined that it was in the best interest of the Village to establish a Drug/Gang/DUI Fund whose purpose is, among other things, to pay the cost of equipment to assist the Village Police Department in performing its duties, and specifically, to assist in the prevention of alcohol-related criminal violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, as a Home Rule Municipality, the following:

Section 1: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2: Creation and Purpose. There shall be and hereby is created a Drug/Gang/DUI Fund in and for the Village whose purpose is, among other things, to purchase law enforcement equipment that will assist in the prevention of alcohol-related criminal violence in the Village.

Section 3: Expenditures. Expenditures made from the Drug/Gang/DUI Fund shall be approved by resolution of the Village Board and, as to monies received pursuant to the DUI Statute, shall be spent in accordance with Subsection 5/11-501(j) of the Illinois Vehicle Code. Expenditures of monies received from other sources, shall be spent to promote the purposes of the Drug/Gang/DUI Fund as reasonably determined by the Village Board.

Section 4: Severability. If any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held or deemed to be invalid, such invalidity shall not have the effect of rendering any other part or provision of this Ordinance invalid.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.
