ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF TITLE 1 OF THE VILLAGE CODE TO CREATE THE OFFICE OF DEPUTY TREASURER

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") has provided for the office of the Village Treasurer;

WHEREAS, from time to time it may become necessary for the Village Treasurer to be absent from his or her position, in which case, the Village finds it necessary to have a deputy treasurer available to fulfill the duties of the Village Treasurer in his or her absence;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code provides that the President of the Village with the advice and consent of the Board of Trustees may appoint offices of the Village, including temporary appointments of specific duration (65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-5(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Incorporation of Preambles.</u> The Village Board hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Deputy Treasurer.

Section 1-6-5 of the Village Code shall be, and the same hereby is, amended to add the following subsection 1-6-5(J):

- (J) Deputy Treasurer, Appointment, Powers and Duties and Compensation: The Village President, with the advice and consent of the Trustees, may, from time to time as necessary, appoint a deputy Village Treasurer to fulfill all of the duties of the Village Treasurer in the absence of the Village Treasurer for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) consecutive days. Compensation of the Deputy Village Treasurer, if any, shall be paid by the Board of Trustees.
- Section 3. Validity. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.
- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Superseder and Effective Date.</u> All resolutions, motions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
