

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 1 OF THE VILLAGE CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") has adopted Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the Village Code setting forth certain committees of the Board of Trustees and specifying the number of members on each such committee; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village find and believe it to be in the best interest of the Village that said Section 11 be amended as provided in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Village Board hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Amendment. Section 11 of Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the Village Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

1-5-11: Committees, Appointments, Reports:

- (A) Appointments: There shall be appointed by the president, with the approval of the trustees, ten (10) standing committees of the board of trustees consisting of two (2) or three (3) members each, as specified and identified below, with each member to be a trustee and the president an ex-officio member of each, as follows:

Building and zoning
Environment
Finance (to consist of 3 members)
Health
Insurance
Municipal building and grounds
Planning
Public safety
Roads and bridges
Village personnel (to consist of 3 members)

The president, with the approval of the trustees, may appoint such other committees as may be deemed necessary.

- (B) Reports: Committees to which matters are referred shall report in writing on the request of any member of the board of trustees.


Section 3. Validity. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4. Superseder and Effective Date. All resolutions, motions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
