

**ORDINANCE NO. 09-08**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 4 OF THE VILLAGE CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") has adopted Chapter 5 of Title 4 of the Village Code (the "Flood Ordinance") in order to comply with the National Flood Insurance Program of the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA"); and

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village find and believe it to be in the best interest of the Village that certain portions of the Flood Ordinance be amended as provided in this Ordinance in order to update the Flood Insurance Rate Maps and Flood Insurance Studies prepared by FEMA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

**Section 1.** Incorporation of Preambles. The Village Board hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

**Section 2.** Flood Insurance Rate Map. The Flood Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby amended by deleting Appendix A to the Flood Ordinance and by inserting the attached Appendix A in lieu thereof.

**Section 3.** Validity. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.


**Section 4.** Superseder and Effective Date. All resolutions, motions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
