## ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 2, BUILDING CODE, SECTION 4-2-7 OF THE VILLAGE CODE RELATIVE TO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village") is a duly organized and existing Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills is authorized and empowered, under the Municipal Code and the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Barrington Hills, to set forth regulations for building within the Village, including but not limited to those regulations relative to emergency communication; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Barrington Hills requires as a means of communicating for emergency services by a hard wire from a residence to the Dispatch Center; and

**WHEREAS** the technology of communication has been supplanted by various other means including wireless.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

**SECTION ONE:** That the forgoing recitals are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**SECTION TWO:** That Title 4, Chapter 2 Building Regulations, Section 4-2-2 BOCA BASIC BUILDING CODE ADOPTED; EXCEPTIONS; ADDITIONS be and hereby is amended as set forth in the provision of Fire Protection Systems/Supervision Section 1020.3, by deleting in its entirety as follows:

1020.3 Emergency Number Telephone System. Notification of the need for emergency services shall be accomplished by a caller through dialing the digits 9-1-1 on a wired line in the public switched telephone network. The telephone connection will originate from the caller's location and terminate at the Barrington Hills police safety answering point, where the telecommunicator will receive a voice connection, call back number and service address of the location of the caller.

**SECTION THREE:** That all other ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

**SECTION FOUR:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
