

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TORCH RUN
BY THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village"), it is for the best interests of the Village to hold the Annual Illinois Special Olympics Torch Run ("Torch Run") on segments of State Routes 62 and 25 in the Village of Barrington Hills ("Route"), on Sunday, June 12, 2005, between 7:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Torch Run will require the partial or complete closing of the streets along the Route; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5/4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/4-408), the Village is required to assume all responsibility and liability involved in the closing of any portion of a State highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake, and McHenry in the State of Illinois, as a home rule municipality the following:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees and found to be true.

Section 2. Responsibility and Liability. The President and Board of Trustees agree that the Village will assume full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of traffic during the time the detour is in effect, and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of the Route.

Section 3. Detours. The President and Board of Trustees further agree that efficient, detours will be maintained, conspicuously marked, and judiciously police patrolled for the benefit of traffic deviated from the Route.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
