

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS
TO POSTPONE FURTHER PUBLIC HEARINGS ON
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING CODE (TITLE 5)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees previously adopted Resolution 08-22, authorizing and directing the Zoning Board of Appeals ("ZBA") to hold a public hearing on proposed amendments to the Zoning Code (Title 5); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that such hearing or hearings should be postponed until the Legal Committee and the Equestrian Commission of the Village has had an opportunity to review and comment on the issues associated with the use of the word agriculture.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois as a Home Rule municipality, that the ZBA is hereby requested to postpone any further public hearings on the proposed amendments to the Zoning Code made a part of Resolution 08-22, until further directed by the Board of Trustees.


This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
