WHEREAS, the Council of Barrington Gardens received and obtained the consent to install a plaque of their Blue Star Highway program at the northeast corner of Old Sutton and Dundee Roads, and

WHEREAS, the location was the recruiting station of 91 volunteers for the Civil War at the original settlement of Miller's Grove latter referred as Barrington Center and now within the municipality of the Village of Barrington Hills, and
