RESOLUTION TO ADOPT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR VILLAGE ROAD DESIGN STANDARDS

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village") maintains approximately 39 miles of roads as identified in the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the roadway cross section profile of Village maintained roads is best described as rural, with roads typically having gravel shoulders, open ditches, limited curb and gutter sections, and canopy roadside landscape; and

WHEREAS, the Roads and Bridges Committee of the Board of Trustees, at a public hearing regarding reconstruction of one such road inclusive of dedicated bicycle travel lanes, heard concerns regarding private property rights, drainage and roadside landscaping; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the public comment received, the Village Board believes it is in the public interest of the residents of the Village to recommend standards for consideration for discussion of future road maintenance and reconstruction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake, and McHenry in the State of Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Standard. The Roads and Bridges Committee is hereby directed to limit its consideration of maintenance, resurfacing, and/or reconstruction of Village maintained roads to exclude bicycle or shared-use paths, bicycle lanes, and pavement markings or signage for shared bicycle lanes.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
