

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE  
BY THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") is a home-rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such is authorized to take all reasonable action pertaining to its affairs in accordance therewith; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Police Department is in need of a new police utility vehicle to adequately perform the duties and obligations of the Village Police Department and to serve and protect the citizens of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Village Police Department that the Village President and Board of Trustees authorize the purchase of a new 2017 Ford Interceptor Police Utility Vehicle at an expense not to exceed \$44,326.00 inclusive of an Extended Premium Care Warranty and Emergency Equipment/Installation; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the recommendation of the Village Police Department, the President and Board of Trustees has determined the purchase of a new Ford Interceptor Police Utility Vehicle, at an expense not to exceed \$44,326.00, is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**SECTION TWO:** The Chief of Police is authorized to purchase a new 2017 Ford Interceptor Police Utility Vehicle at an expense not to exceed \$44,326.00 inclusive of an Extended Premium Care Warranty and Emergency Equipment/Installation, to be taken from the Village General Fund.

**SECTION THREE:** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
