Re: Plan Commission Meeting 4/13

The Plan Commission held its regular meeting on Wednesday April 13th. It should be noted that this was the first meeting in 2016 of the quarterly calendar of meetings.

The Plan Commission continued its consideration of amendment of the Tree Preservation Ordinance (4-6-1) by reviewing a document that contained both the existing language and proposed. The proposed language was created from a review with the Village's Forester, Chuck Stewart and Commissioner Joyce and was first introduced at its February meeting. The document as reviewed was posted on line prior to the meeting with the agenda for April.

There also was submitted for reference, a planting index prepared by the Morton Arboretum to attain diversity in the landscape. It was included with the discussion of cultivars.

After the review items to be undertaken for the next regularly scheduled meeting would be (1) review of the statement of purpose and intent, (2) research with the Village Attorney the practice of using a letter of credit or performance bond to ensure the completion of the Tree Preservation Plan.

The Commission indicated an availability of a Special Meeting should there be a requirement by petition or interest for a meeting before the next regular meeting in July.
