To Whom it May Concern:

I live in the Glenmore subdivision on the west side of Haegers Bend Rd. (South of Spring Creek Road and North of Lake Cook Rd.) Glenmore residents are very much tied to Barrington Hills:

- The land was de-annexed from Barrington Hills approx. 25 yrs. Ago.
  - Our Homeowners Association is required to seek approval from BH for any change to our covenants.
  - We pay taxes to the Barrington Hills Park District.
  - We are part of the Barrington library district.

Our 70 well-kept homes sit on ¼ lots which abut Barrington Hills to our North and Haegers Bend Road to our east. Just as we are advantaged by our proximity to the beautiful rural feel and open spaces in Barrington Hills, Barrington Hills is advantaged by its proximity to our neat and attractive (though smaller homes) We are good neighbors.

It is not uncommon for communities to band together when common threats arise. Recent examples:

- Communities from Crystal Lake to Naperville and beyond (including the “Barringtons”) continue to fight Canadian National Railroad, fearing its poor safety record, increased frequency, double decker cars, and blocked access to emergency services.
- Together, surrounding communities battled the auto wrecking facility and resulting pollution in East Dundee.

*I am opposed to widening Haegers Bend Road as a part of repair and improvement. I ask that, in the process of necessary improvements to Haegers Bend Road, that widening be limited to a 1 ft. apron and that residents be notified and have opportunity to address any planned removal of vegetation which may be deemed necessary in the reconstruction process before it is accomplished.*

- The ROW for Glenmore is an alarming 40 ft. from the Haegers Bend Road center line.
  - Barrington Hills properties along the same road have a prescriptive easement in place offering much more protection.
- Our homes, on smaller lots, sit much closer to the road than our neighbor’s homes in Barrington Hills. The property values and tranquil lifestyle in our small subdivision would be severely compromised should Haegers Bend be widened.
  - Trees and other screening vegetation would be lost.
  - A wider, more easily driven roadway may eventually bring:
    - Increased traffic
    - Higher allowable vehicle gross weight.
    - Increased speed limits.



*I am opposed to removal of the island at Haegers Bend Road and Spring Creek Road.*

- The island makes Haegers Bend a less attractive conduit route than many others because it:
  - Slows traffic.
  - Makes some turns difficult.
  - Decreases tendencies to run or miss the stop sign.

*I am opposed to bicycle paths in Barrington Hills and on Haegers Bend Road because:*

- The narrow and tree-canopied rural roads and open spaces in Barrington Hills lend significantly to property values in the whole area.
  - Trees, hedges, attractive and expensive driveway entrances, vegetation which narrows wildlife and vegetation which provides screening for residents would be lost.
  - The rural and peaceful feel of the community would be compromised.
- Property to accommodate bicycle paths would have to be taken by Eminent Domain, a distasteful way to wrest property from our neighbors.
- Large, disrespectful, and often unruly bands of bicyclists already travel from great distances to ride through Barrington Hills.
  - They create traffic and safety issues.
- Creating bicycle lanes will increase bicycle traffic and bicycle related issues, thus taxing the Barrington Hills Police Dept.

While we are separate communities, we are tied together in innumerable ways. We retain separate identities as communities, but must remain responsible to one another in the larger sense of "community". Each of us, as individuals and as separate communities must take care of one another. In doing so, we take the greatest care of our respective interests.

We would like our comments to be placed in the public record regarding the potential for changes to HAEGERS BEND ROAD, scheduled to be discussed on July 16, 2014.

We, Steven and Lisa Schroeder, are residents of Barrington Hills, Illinois, residing at 207 Spring Creek Road. We believe the proposed changes to Haegers Bend Road will increase neighborhood traffic and the addition of bike lanes will impact negatively our lifestyle and daily routines as follows:

- Currently, numerous cyclists ride in a dangerous manner on Spring Creek Road. These individuals: fan out across the road, are loud at early hours on weekends, are rude to our residents, and most importantly, trespass on our property (including urinating on our lawns). The addition of bike lanes will invite more of this unacceptable behavior.
- Removal of Island at Spring Creek and Haegers Bend Intersection. We are concerned for our two daughters safety (ages 5 and 13). Currently, it is difficult enough to police the speeders on Spring Creek Road. Opening up traffic will only increase the potential for more speeders and provide for more dangerous conditions on our street.
- Widening roads. Widening our roads will deplete our property values, add construction and traffic congestion, while destroying our trees.
- Plans to relocate 20 utility poles at the "expense of others." We are opposed to moving the utility poles and residents being expected to absorb the related costs.
- No Special Road Signs. Signs that mark a bike path invite more cyclists. The existing signs requiring single file riding for cyclists is sufficient for safety purposes.

Tonight our residents finally have their say in the ongoing battle of incorporating bike lanes into Barrington Hills, or do they? The issue of transparency and timely delivery of documents along with the corresponding dialogue between our village local and state planning agencies is a major question mark. From as far back as 2012, it crystal clear that the decision makers have been filtering information from the public and those in charge are acting with omnipotence.

With the deadline of August 15<sup>th</sup> less than a month away, residents have yet to see the original application letter rejected by the county! Unless a drawn out FOIA request is made, the letter is not readily available to review.

All studies reviewed mention Algonguin/River, Spring Creek, Braeburn and Plum tree and Ridge road for possible bicycle modifications. The jewel in the crown among all these roads is Haeger's Bend. With its superb northerly location, accessibility to major intersections and it's ideal connectivity to the existing trail systems make it the ultimate "yellow brick road" in the region. Residents are wondering what will be the referendum vote of our village board on bike lanes? What opinions and comments from residents in a revised application should one be approved; be featured in a new application?

President McLaughlin should seriously consider naming a resident(s) from each of the named roads to serve on an auxiliary resident panel so they can review firsthand the results from the survey and questionnaire and serve on the review committee. Doing so will provide give oversight and provide accountability to the residents who will bear the weight of any decisions made. Currently, only individuals three decided who will determine the direction of the village's bike plan submission. It is high time our residents have a seat at the infrastructure table and have a stake in the final result.

The Haeger's Bend questionnaire is a perfect example of presenting information in such way to elicit a desired outcome. The questions for this survey should have come from the residents; for instance: Do you want a bike lane/path on your road? Or are you willing to perpetually be taxed into infinity to cover costs related to endless infrastructure improvements? Not the insertion of free funding as it is contingent to paving a road! This phraseology confuses people and causes panic. Any questions regarding eminent domain permission from residents are premature, and offensive.

The issue remains the short and long term results of creating customized amusement lanes for a very narrow segment of users. Yes the bikers are here, however, the pelotons who use our village roads regard our hilly roads as their personal figure eight speed track every weekend. Cycling websites advertise "how much fun" it is to cycle in our village! The problem comes in that these riders make no apologies for violating the single file rule and blowing through stop signs. There are bike attorneys now whose job is to represent injured cyclists. Suburbs who consider these types of bike lanes face a liability disincentive if they add such lanes. The consequences of such accommodations can't be minimized. Our village should not consider making such modifications now or ever!

The island is an important safety feature and should not be removed as it helps disperse traffic volume from our area. We need these safeguards to remain in place!

Our community has idyllic attributes and superlative topography which should be preserved and not altered. Cutting down Mr. Fitch's majestic oaks at the northern corridor of our village and destroying the landscape is truly a sinful disregard of our Comprehensive plan. By honoring these proposals we are exposing our area to extensive suburbanization and traffic gridlock, and further depressed property values for homes. The possible sale of the Duda property with high density housing will be another complicating factor.



The scope, magnitude and cost of such a plan can't be devalued or quantified! It is potentially transformative and if approved will change our town forever. Please remember that this issue will have a domino effect, once the first road falls, the others will undoubtedly suffer the same fate. We have the power to keep that from happening and our representatives owe us that protection.
