Mr. Kosin,

On Monday, March 18, 2013 MAP informed the Village that the Supplemental Arbitration Award has been issued by the Tri-Arbitration Panel. MAP's position is that even though Tri-Panel Member President Abboud did not sign the Supplemental Arbitration Award because a majority of the Tri-Panel Members did sign it such constitutes a Final Action of the Tri-Panel. Consequently, MAP argues that the Supplemental Arbitration Award is considered "issued" for purposes of review by the Board of Trustees.

Without waiving any possible argument that the Supplemental Tri-Panel Arbitration Award was not properly issued we ask that the Village Board of Trustees review and vote on each term decided by the Arbitration Panel in its Supplemental Tri-Panel Arbitration Award. Note that the Arbitration Panel, in its Supplemental Tri-Panel Arbitration Award, decided that it will not modify in any way any of the items initially rejected by the Village; therefore each item remained the same as in the Initial Arbitration Award and must, once again, be reviewed and voted on by the Village Board of Trustees. This request is made based upon 5 ILCS 315/14 (n) of the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act which states in pertinent part:

"Any supplemental decision by an arbitration panel or other decision maker agreed to by the parties shall be submitted to the governing body for ratification and adoption in accordance with the procedures and voting requirements set forth in this Section."

(EMPHASIS ADDED)

Please include such on the Agenda for the Monday, March 25, 2013 Board of Trustees Meeting. It should be placed under Public Safety - "consideration of Supplemental Tri-Panel Arbitration Award to determine approval or disapproval. When such determination is made is shall be stated that such was done without waiving any possible argument that the Supplemental Tri-Panel Arbitration Panel Award was not properly issued."
