ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-6-2 OF THE VILLAGE CODE

WHEREAS, The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village find and believe it to be in the best interest of the Village that Section 9-6-2 of the Village Code be amended to require motor vehicles owned by residents of the Village and sited in the Village to purchase a motor vehicle license as provided in 65 ILCS 5/2-121.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Village Board hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. License Required. Section 9-6-2 of the Village Code, shall be, and the same hereby is, deleted in its entirety and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

9-6-2: LICENSE REQUIRED: Every motor vehicle which has its situs or base within the Village and is:

(A) used by the resident and garaged at the resident's home or

(B) a company car, owned by a company with its principal place of business located outside of the Village, and used by a resident-employee and garaged by a resident of the Village,

shall have a motor vehicle license issued annually by the Village upon payment of a fee and said license shall be displayed on the windshield of the motor vehicle. However, a resident owner shall not be required to display on his vehicle, the license number issued by the Village, if his vehicle is displaying the plate or tax or license number issued by the place wherein the vehicle has its situs or base.

Section 3. Validity. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4. Superseder and Effective Date. All resolutions, motions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby

superseded; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
