

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4 "BUILDING REGULATIONS" BY SPECIFIC REFERENCE OF FIRE PREVENTION CODE & ADDING THE 2008 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills, a home rule municipality (the "Village") heretofore enacted Ordinances adopting building Codes in the Village for the protection and preservation of the health, safety and general welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, said Codes govern construction, materials, fire prevention electrical, plumbing, sanitary, potable water and all activities necessary for a habitable or safe building and structure; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Village to maintain current and reasonable codes of construction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois as a Home Rule Municipality the following:

SECTION ONE: Title 4, Chapter 2 hereby amended by deleting in its entirety Section 4-2-4 and replacing said language so that said section shall be and read as follows:

4-2-4: NFPA NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE ADOPTED; EXCEPTIONS; ADDITIONS:

(A) Adopted: The national fire protection association national electrical code, 2008 edition (NFPA 70-2008) is hereby adopted by reference as the electrical code of the village subject to such deletions and additions of sections as are hereinafter provided.

(B) Exceptions: In lieu of Article 334, nonmetallic sheathed cable: Types nm, nmc and nms all lighting and receptacle circuits must be enclosed in electrical metallic tubing, except for flexible metallic drops not to exceed four feet (4') in length.

(C) Promulgation of Rules: The president and board of trustees may adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this chapter as may be recommended by the building officer of the Village acting as electrical commission or the chief electrical inspector;

SECTION TWO: Should any part of provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

SECTION THREE: this ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form.


