ORDINANCE AMENDING REGULATIONS REGARDING BONDS FOR RAFFLES AS SET FORTH IN TITLE 3, CHAPTER 7, SECTION 10 IN THE VILLAGE CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village") is a duly organized and existing Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills is authorized and empowered, under the Illinois Municipal Code and the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village Code"), to adopt regulations for the conduct of business within the Village, including but not limited to those relative to the conduct of raffles; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has previously adopted regulations on the conduct of raffles within the Village, which regulations are set forth in the Village Code in Title 3, "Business Regulations," as Chapter 7, "Raffles;" and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has previously adopted regulations on bonds for raffles conducted within the Village, which regulations are set forth in the Village Code in Title 3, Chapter 7, as Section 10, "Manager; Bond;" and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees deem it prudent and necessary for equitable enforcement to amend provisions relative to the requirement of bonds for certain raffles by amending Title 3, Chapter 7, Section 10 of the Village Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

SECTION ONE: That the forgoing recitals are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: That Title 3, Chapter 7, Section 10 of the Village Code, entitled "Manager; Bond," is hereby amended to state as follows:

3-7-10: MANAGER; BOND:

All operation of and the conduct of raffles shall be under the supervision of a single raffle manager designated by the organization. If the individual or combined value of all items to be raffled exceeds ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), the manager shall give a fidelity bond in the sum of an amount determined by the village clerk, in favor of the organization, conditioned upon his or her honesty in the performance of his or her duties. Terms of the bond shall provide that notice shall be given in writing to the village not less than thirty (30) days prior to its cancellation. The village clerk may waive this bond requirement by including a waiver provision in the license issued to an organization under this chapter, provided that a unanimous vote of the village board of Trustees has approved the waiver of the raffle manager's bond.

SECTION THREE: That all other ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
