

VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS
RESOLUTION ON CELLULAR TELEPHONE SERVICE

WHEREAS; the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village"), its police force and its residents are increasingly reliant on the provision of reliable, quality cellular telephone service for matters of public safety; and

WHEREAS; concerns have been raised on an increasingly frequent basis that cellular telephone service in the Village is very inconsistent, and quite weak in many parts of the Village, and

WHEREAS; the Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, in recognition of the above factors, formed a Technology Committee to specifically gather and analyze data and resident opinion on the need for and the quality of cellular telephone service in the Village; and

WHEREAS; the Technology Committee has reported its findings to the Board of Trustees, to wit, a substantial majority of the residents responding to a survey stated that cellular service was less than satisfactory, a canvassing of the carriers serving Village residents report less than acceptable coverage in large areas of the Village, Exhibit A, attached hereto, represents identified search areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Lake, Kane and McHenry Counties, as a home rule municipality the following:

Section One. That the Village, through the Technology Committee, work with cellular telephone providers to find suitable locations within the Village, subject in all cases to the provisions of the Village Zoning Code, to locate sufficient multiple-carrier cellular telephone transmission towers to provide reliable, quality cellular telephone service to all residents of the Village.

Section Two. If any part or provision of this Resolution shall be held or deemed to be invalid, such invalidity shall not have the affect of rendering another part or provision of this Resolution invalid.


Section Three. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
