## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADVOCATE HEALTH CARE NETWORK "THE RUN FOR THE ARTS" RACE BY THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS

**WHEREAS**, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village"), it is for the best interests of the Village to hold its "Run for the Arts" Race on the route attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "Marked Route") BEGINNING AT 7:30 a.m. on July 4, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the "Run For The Arts" will require the partial or complete closing of the streets located on the Marked Route; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 5/4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/4-408), the Village is required to assume all responsibility and liability involved in the closing of any portion of a State highway;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, a home rule municipality located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake, and McHenry in the State of Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1**. **Recitals**. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

**Section 2. Responsibility and Liability.** The President and Board of Trustees agree that the Village will assume full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of traffic on the Marked Route during the time the detour is in effect, and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of said Marked Route.

**Section 3. Detours.** The President and Board of Trustees further agree that efficient, all weather detours allowing traffic around the Marked Route. Such detours conspicuously marked and judiciously police patrolled by the Village Police Department for the benefit of traffic detouring from the Marked Route.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
