A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND THE METROPOLITAN ALLIANCE OF POLICE, CHAPTER #576

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") is a home-rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such is authorized to take all reasonable action pertaining to its affairs in accordance therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Village and the Metropolitan Alliance of Police, Chapter #576 (the "Union") have been in on-going negotiations concerning a collective bargaining agreement applicable to the Village and Union Members; and

WHEREAS, Village and Union representatives have reached a tentative agreement as to some but not all terms of a collective bargaining agreement as more fully set forth in the "Memorandum of Agreement" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, based on staff recommendation, the President and Board of Trustees have determined execution of Memorandum of Understanding as set forth in Exhibit "A" is in the best interests of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry, Illinois, as follows:

<u>SECTION ONE:</u> The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION TWO:</u> The Village President is authorized to execute the Memorandum of Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and the Village Clerk to attest thereto.

<u>SECTION THREE:</u> That the Village Chief of Police and appointed staff be, and hereby is, directed to work with the Union to best effect the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding.

SECTION FOUR: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
