

CUBA ROAD BRIDGE – CONSTRUCTION AND CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING LOCAL AGENCY AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the “Village”) is a home-rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such is authorized to take all reasonable action pertaining to its affairs in accordance therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously authorized, by adoption of Resolution 15-11, the execution of an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation (“IDOT”) for engineering work associated with Cuba Road, under a local agency agreement for cost sharing of said work; and

WHEREAS, due to delays incurred in the work as a result of utility relocations, the Village is now required to enter into an agreement with IDOT amending its cost sharing of construction engineering costs to the amount of \$175,860.00 and construction costs in the amount of \$1,182,000.00, of which the Village shall pay 20%, which agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit “A;” and

WHEREAS, based on engineering staff recommendation, the President and Board of Trustees has determined execution of the agreement with IDOT for the reasons and at the cost set forth in Exhibit “A” is in the best interests of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO: The Village President is authorized to execute the engineering construction and construction costs agreement with IDOT as attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” and the Village Clerk to attest thereto.


SECTION THREE: That the Village Administrator and appointed staff be, and hereby is, directed to work with the Village’s engineers to best effect the terms of the amendment.

SECTION FOUR: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
