Chapter 6 - Tree Preservation

Tree Removal Permit ("TRP") shall be required for the destruction or removal of any "Heritage Tree" (see section 4-6-8) in any woodland. No person shall, directly or indirectly remove, damage or destroy a woodland without having secured a TRP. Defined Woodland: Eight (8) or more Heritage Trees on a site within circular area having a radius not to exceed 117.8 feet and shall include all such trees within the woodland regardless of the number of such trees. A site may encompass one or more woodlands.
