Barrington Hills Officer Involved Traffic Crash

On Tuesday August 5, 2025, at 11:33 pm, an on-duty Barrington Hills Police officer was involved in a traffic crash with a motorcycle.

The preliminary investigation indicates a 2013 Suzuki motorcycle was travelling northbound on Bartlett Road, failed to negotiate the curve, struck a utility pole, and then collided with the marked police vehicle, which was stopped at the stop sign on Old Bartlett Road at the intersection with Bartlett Road.

The officer was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries, treated, and later released. The motorcyclist, an 18-year-old male, was transported to a local hospital where he remains in critical but stable condition. Speed likely was a contributing factor; however, the crash remains under investigation by the Major Crash Assistance Team.

The roadway was re-opened to traffic by 5:00 am on Wednesday.
