

**RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING NIKKI PANOS AS VILLAGE CLERK
OF THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (hereinafter the “Village”) is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution and is empowered by the Illinois Constitution to enact all constitutional ordinances, resolutions and motions and to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to the Village’s local government and affairs, subject to any express limitation provided by the Illinois General Assembly in the manner provided in Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, the Village President has the power to appoint a Village Clerk, with the concurrence of the Board of Trustees through adoption of a resolution by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Board, for such term as shall be determined by the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, Nikki Panos was appointed the Village Clerk for a term from January 1, 2018 to May 2021 and a term from May 2021 to May 2025; and

WHEREAS, Nikki Panos has excelled in the performance the duties and responsibilities of the Office of Village Clerk, and for this reason, the President recommends that Nikki Panos be reappointed by the Village Board to a four-year term of Office to commence on June 1, 2025, at an annual salary as approved by the Village Board as part of adoption of the annual budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

SECTION ONE: The Village President, with the concurrence of at least two-thirds of the Trustees on the Village Board, hereby appoints Nikki Panos as Village Clerk with all the duties, responsibilities and authority of said Office as set forth in Illinois Law and within the Village Code, Title I, Chapter 6.

SECTION TWO: The term of the Village Clerk shall commence on June 1, 2025, and shall be for four years, running through May 31, 2029.

SECTION THREE: That all other ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication, as provided herein.

SECTION FIVE: If any portion of this Ordinance is ruled or held to be unenforceable or invalid for any reason, the enforceability thereof shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be construed as if not containing the particular provision and shall continue in full force, effect and enforceability.
