

**RESOLUTION APPROVING
THE 2026 STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM PLAN (SMPP) AND AUTHORIZING
ITS USE FOR THE COLLECTION OF DATA NECESSARY TO PREPARE THE VILLAGE'S
ANNUAL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) REPORT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (hereinafter the "Village") is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution and is empowered by the Illinois Constitution to enact all constitutional ordinances, resolutions and motions and to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to the Village's local government and affairs, subject to any express limitation provided by the Illinois General Assembly in the manner provided in Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village") owns and operates a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System ("MS4") and is subject to the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") General Permit for Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (ILR40) issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"); and

WHEREAS, the Illinois EPA requires the Village to develop, implement, and maintain a Stormwater Management Program ("SMP") that addresses the Minimum Control Measures established under the ILR40 General Permit; and

WHEREAS, the Village has prepared a 2026 Stormwater Management Program Plan (SMPP) that identifies the Best Management Practices (BMPs), measurable goals, responsible parties, implementation schedules, and documentation procedures necessary to satisfy the requirements of the ILR40 General Permit; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois EPA further requires the Village to submit an Annual MS4 Report documenting implementation of the Stormwater Management Program and demonstrating compliance with the requirements of the ILR40 General Permit; and

WHEREAS, maintaining complete, accurate, and timely documentation throughout the reporting year is necessary to prepare the Annual MS4 Report and demonstrate the Village's continued compliance with applicable state and federal stormwater regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Village Trustees have determined that the 2026 Stormwater Management Program Plan provides an effective framework for documenting stormwater management activities and collecting the information necessary for preparation of the Village's Annual MS4 Report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry in the State of Illinois, a home rule municipality, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: The Village Trustees hereby approves the 2026 Stormwater Management Program Plan (SMPP) as the Village's official management document for implementation of its Stormwater Management Program during calendar year 2026.

SECTION THREE: The Village Trustees authorize Village staff, consultants, and other designated personnel responsible for implementation of the Stormwater Management Program to utilize the 2026 SMPP for collecting, documenting, and maintaining records of activities performed in support of the Village's MS4 Program.

SECTION FOUR: The Village Administrator, Village Engineer, or their designee is hereby authorized to compile the information collected pursuant to the 2026 SMPP and prepare or cause to be prepared the Village's Annual MS4 Report for submission to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency in accordance with the requirements of the ILR40 General Permit.

SECTION FIVE: The Village Administrator and Village Engineer are authorized to implement administrative revisions to the 2026 Stormwater Management Program Plan that are necessary to improve program implementation or comply with changes in applicable laws, regulations, or permit requirements, provided such revisions do not materially alter Village policy without further approval of the Village Trustees.

SECTION SIX: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
